The Appliance Repair Program

House of Friendship's Appliance Repair Technician fixes major household appliances at a reduced fee for families living on low-income in the Region.

Through this program, families receiving social assistance have repairs to major household appliances subsidized by the Region of Waterloo.

Families living on low-income who do not qualify for subsidy from the Region can also be served by this program; they can pay House of Friendship directly for more affordable appliance repairs.

The Appliance Repair Technician also educates customers about preventative maintenance of their major appliances.

This program is made possible through the Region of Waterloo, client fees, and donations to House of Friendship.
