- House of Friendship is a non-profit human service agency founded in 1939. Its mission is to serve low-income people in need of support and to promote opportunities for personal growth, wholesome relationships and community development through the application of holistic Christian principles.
- House of Friendship provides a Program Coordinator and Outreach Worker for the centre along with part-time staff for specific programs.
- Some funding for programs is provided to House of Friendship by the City of Kitchener and by the United Way of Kitchener-Waterloo and Area. Additional funding is provided through donations to House of Friendship.
