Courtland-Shelley Community Centre is a program of House of Friendship's Family Services Division.

House of Friendship's mission is to serve low-income people in need of support, and to promote opportunities for personal growth, wholesome relationships, and community development through the application of holistic Christian principles.

The program receives funding from United Way of K-W and Area, Rockway Mennonite Church, a variety of program-specific grants and general donations to House of Friendship.

Connecting to the Global Village

Courtland-Shelley Community Centre is a public internet access site provided through Industry Canada's Urban Community Access Program (CAP). Kevin, the computer instructor, describes how this program is used.

"Variety is the best word to describe our participants. The ages vary from five year-old Omer to moms with children attending university. Of course Omer enjoys games while his older sister enjoys socializing on the web or doing research for homework. Most adults receive tutoring but a few come in to check e-mail or search for jobs on the Web."

Many participants have signed up for e-mail accounts and are now able to contact family and friends around the world! It was especially touching when one mom received her first reply from her son who is away at university. She really surprised him. Mom is now a member of the computer age!"
