Our History ...

The Sunnydale Community Association (SCA) began providing programs to the Sunnydale community in 1997 through resident volunteers.

In 1999, the SCA formed a partnership with House of Friendship, Waterloo Region Housing and other community partners.

Waterloo Region Housing provides a townhouse unit at 508-H Sunnydale Place that serves as a community centre. House of Friendship provides the Community Resource Coordinator, additional staffing and program support.

The Centre receives funding from United Way of Kitchener-Waterloo & Area, the Wallenstein Feed Foundation and the City of Waterloo.

The SCA works at forming partnerships to bring resources and programs to the community. Local churches have provided ongoing support in various ways since 1997.

The work of the Executive Council of the SCA is assisted through volunteer positions such as:

A Program of House of Friendship

- Sunnydale Community Centre is a program of House of Friendship's Family Services Division.
- House of Friendship is a Christian, non-profit human service agency founded in 1939. It operates programs in Addiction Services, Community Services, Family Services and Residential Services (please see back panel).
- House of Friendship's mission is to serve low-income adults, youth and children in need of support and to promote opportunities for personal growth, wholesome relationships and community development through the application of holistic Christian principles.
