**PROGRAM:** Alcontrol is a women's specific, addiction treatment program offering assessment/screening, residential, day and community treatment services. In addition, Alcontrol provides specialized services to women who are pregnant. There are 9 treatment beds in the residential program which operates with a 24 hour staffing model.

**PURPOSE:** To provide addiction counselling within the Alcontrol program.

- 10. Strong interest in working with low income people in need of support
- 11. Experience and a strong interest in working with diverse populations from various cultural backgrounds and income levels, and sensitivity to their needs
