POSITION: Early Intervention Addiction Counsellor

PROGRAM: Bridges to Health

PROGRAM: The well regarded Day Treatment Program provides evidence based treatment services for adults who are concerned about their substance use. This program is portable and travels to sites outside of its' K-W home base office to deliver services (Guelph, Cambridge). It is anticipated the two week intensive treatment program will run up to twenty times per year with intake, information sessions, screening, aftercare and other specialized workshops in between. There is also programming designed to meet the needs of specific populations.

9. Valid G-Class driver's license and access to a reliable vehicle
10. Desire and ability to work sensitively and effectively with people from various abilities, life situations and cultural backgrounds

POSITION DETAILS:

- Works as a member of a participant focused team in a supportive environment
- There is some travel to locations in the greater Waterloo/Wellington area
- Required to work intensively with program participants in emotionally charged situations
- Required to assess situations and make decisions under pressure with minimal supervision
